The “Partial Birth Abortion” Ban: Health Care in the Shadow of Criminal Liability

The Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act imposes criminal liability on physicians who perform the procedure of intact dilation and extraction. Last term, in *Gonzales v. Carhart*, the U.S. Supreme Court upheld the validity of the Act against constitutional challenge. In this symposium, legal scholars and medical practitioners will assess *Carhart*'s likely effects on health care, including physicians' professional medical judgments and patients' access to treatment.
